AN ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL PROJECT

Oasi Zegna was created in 1993 as a natural development of the “green thought” of Ermenegildo Zegna, the entrepreneur and philanthropist who started in the ‘30s to fund and implement a far-reaching program of social and environmental improvements in the mountains around Trivero-Valdilana (Biella), which is still the site of the Ermenegildo Zegna wool mill.

Oasi Zegna is now a freely accessible protected mountain area of around 100 Km². It’s an ideal place for leisure and sport, throughout the year and with full respect for local ecosystems. It has numerous tourist facilities (offering services and hospitality typical of mountain culture and traditions) grouped under a Tourism Consortium that promotes the area.

It is also one of the cells of the Ecomuseo del Biellese, a museum focusing on the historical and cultural heritage of alpine agriculture in the area.

In July 2016, Oasi Zegna -Ezre obtained the prestigious Quality Label Level I from the Swiss Tourism Federation, following a program of quality improvement launched in 2013.

This major certification reflects ongoing commitment to improving territorial management and promotion and the engagement of stakeholders.

One of the priorities for Oasi Zegna’s management is now to extend this Quality Label to the operators in its Consorzio Turistico (Tourism



THE THREE IDENTITIES OF OASI ZEGNA

THE SYENITE ROAD

This is the lower mountainous part overlooking the Torrente Cervo. Rich in geological interest and still inhabited villages, it offers a genuine example of mid-montane life. The vegetation has alpine characteristics and the landscapes are modeled by glaciers that filled the course of the Cervo. It is characterized by syenite, a magmatic rock formed over 30 million years ago and which is still worked by local artisans with their chisels.

THE ROAD OF THE PASSES

This is the mid-montane part crossed by a large section of the Panoramica Zegna road. In the middle of it is Biellmonte, a tourist resort built in the '50s and now at the heart of Oasi Zegna. On the northern flank, the road links a number of passes ("bocchette") to reach Alta Valsessera, the wildest and most uncontaminated zone of Oasi Zegna.

THE RHODODENDRON ROAD

This is the "garden" part of Oasi Zegna created in the '50s adjacent to the Ermenegildo Zegna wool mill. Following the work of the illustrious Florentine landscape architect Pietro Porcinai at the end of the '60s, it was recently extended by Paolo Pejrone. The result is an explosion of colorful blooms (rhododendrons and hydrangeas in May and June) that paint the mountainside.

- TO DESIGN** a territorial improvement initiative to create a "communicating" environment that promotes dialog between humans and nature.

- TO COMMUNICATE** an image of enlightened enterprise capable of identifying needs and implementing projects to satisfy them.

- TO INTERVENE** on a voluntary basis to safeguard the territory, restore equilibrium between eco-systems and favor accessibility to natural resources.
- TO PROMULGATE** a "modus vivendi" rooted in antique values but also in highly modern concepts such as environmental culture and interrelations between eco-systems.
- TO RECORD** the characteristics of Oasi Zegna's territory in terms of flora and fauna, minerals and anthropology.
- TO PROMOTE** scientific, cultural and environmental education initiatives strictly connected with the eco-system in which the area is located.
- TO FOSTER** educational activity by creating a system of communication to promote Oasi Zegna's objectives.
- TO DEVELOP** infrastructure enabling people to enjoy the territory in line with the principles outlined above.

NATURAL ATTRACTIONS
AND COLLABORATIONS TO SAFEGUARD SPECIES

OASI ZEGNA AND THE LIFE PROJECT



The emblem of Oasi Zegna has always been the splendid *Carabus olympiae*, an endemic species of beetle that almost disappeared in the '90s due to excessive capture by collectors.

Under the European Community's LIFE Natura, a program safeguarding species threatened by extinction, the LIFE Carabus project (launched in 2012) aims to reduce the threats to the *Carabus olympiae* of the Alpi Biellesi through management and conservation of the species' preferred habitats in Alta Valsessera. The project is a joint effort between Ermenegildo Zegna, Regione Piemonte, Turin's Università degli Studi, D.R.E.Am. Italia soc. coop. Agricolo-Forestale and Comunità Montana "Val Sessera, Valle di Mosso e Prealpi Biellesi". In addition to conservation of the species, the LIFE Carabus project organizes special initiatives focusing on the territory for visitors to Oasi Zegna and also addresses the general public and schools on-line at www.lifecarabus.eu.

One of Oasi Zegna's priority objectives is environmental education, particularly for the new generations, for whom guided tours focusing on the territory's numerous natural attractions are organized on a regular basis. A systematic nature survey of Oasi Zegna and Alta Valsessera has been conducted in collaboration with Milan's Natural History Museum since 1998. The results have been published in the Oasi Zegna Guide Books (on botany, entomology, zoology and ornithology), which are also ideal for use in schools. The Museum in Milan has a diorama of a golden eagle (*Aquila chrysaetos*), a majestic predator frequently sighted in Valsessera, a Site of Community Interest (SCI) in the European Natura 2000 network.

Landscape management

HUMAN SETTLEMENTS IN MOUNTAIN TERRITORY

MAIN OBJECTIVES

1. In-depth management designed to conserve the highlands by maintaining their mountain settlements. The alpine pastures at Moncerchio and Margosio have become cells of the Ecomuseo Biellese and are valuable resources for transmitting the values of alpine agriculture, also through tastings of typical products and education and awareness raising events.
2. Landscape development, an activity to share with the community. This started in the '30s with a major forestry program involving the planting of over 500,000 conifers and hundreds of rhododendrons and hydrangeas and continued over the decades with various studies and mountain habitat reclamation and maintenance activities.

ZEGNA BABY FOREST

In 2011, in line with its commitment to environmental conservation, Ermenegildo Zegna Group launched the “Zegna Baby Forest”, a project that plants a tree in Oasi Zegna for every baby born to the Group’s 7,000 employees. The project has already helped consolidate terrain under the risk of avalanche in winter season.



THE SMILING FOREST AND FOREST BATHING

Walking in a forest is healthy for the spirit and for the health. The practice of Forest Bathing originated in Japan, where it plays an important role in preventive medicine. Walking in and exploring the woods, especially if they have certain biological characteristics, reduces stress and depression. The beech woods in Oasi Zegna have a high capacity to release volatile substances (monoterpenes) from their foliage and this has a beneficial effect on our immune defense. 

CULTURAL VALUES



Trivero-Valdilana is a pleasant locality at around 800 meters above sea level. Its landscape is characterized by spruce woods, chestnut, beech and ash. The numerous villages making up the municipality of Trivero-Valdilana surround the industrial center of the Wool Mill and Centro Zegna, at the beginning of the 26 km Panoramica road up into Valle Cervo. Started in 1938 by Ermenegildo Zegna, this road crosses Oasi Zegna to provide easy access to the numerous paths that lead into the wild Valsessera, thus leaving behind the more anthropized side of Biella's territory.

ERMENEGILDO ZEGNA WOOL MILL

Founded in 1910 by the Biella industrialist Ermenegildo Zegna, this wool mill in Trivero -Valdilana, at the bottom end of the Panoramica Zegna road, processes the most precious raw materials, such as merino wool, kid mohair, cashmere and vicuña. Already widespread in the middle ages, the art of working wool became established in the Biella area thanks to its abundance and quality of water, the softest in Europe. It is this property of the water, so essential in the wool transformation cycle, that explains the secret of the excellence of the fabrics this mill produces for men's fashion.



CASA ZEGNA


Trivero-Valdilana is also the location of Casa Zegna, housing the historical archives and cultural center. Designed to be an innovative archive and museum concept in a building from the '30s that was once the family's home, it now has, in addition to a splendid collection of textile samples, from 1859 to the present day, a permanent exhibition and a space for temporary exhibitions and teaching (photo 8). In spring and autumn, Casa Zegna opens every Sunday from 14.00 to 18.00. Entry is free of charge and expert personnel are on hand to help visitors. www.casaze-

The "hot" process used is very old and doesn't involve lactic cultures or other additives. The local farmers also offer goat's milk cheeses, fresh and matured. At the Moncerchio and Margosio dairies it's also possible to see the milk being worked and take part in workshops.




